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Пояснительная записка

Дополнительная общеобразовательная (общеразвивающая) программа «Английский язык для общих целей и Разговорные клубы. Уровни Beginner-Advanced» предназначена для совершенствования коммуникативной компетенции взрослых учащихся в сфере английского языка для общих целей в рамках тематики курса обучения с упором на практику устной речи и разговорного английского языка. Программа направлена на создание и обеспечение необходимых условий для личностного развития, творческого труда обучающихся и удовлетворение их образовательных потребностей и интересов.

В основе программы лежат следующие **федеральные нормативные акты**:

- Федеральный закон от 29 декабря 2012 г. №273-ФЗ «Об образовании в Российской Федерации»;
- Закон Российской Федерации от 07 февраля 1992 г. № 2300–1 «О защите прав потребителей»;
- Порядок организации и осуществления образовательной деятельности по дополнительным профессиональным программам. Приказ МОиН РФ от 01.07.2013 №499;
- Порядок организации и осуществления образовательной деятельности по дополнительным общеобразовательным программам. Приказ Министерства просвещения РФ от 9 ноября 2018 г. N 196;
- Показатели, характеризующие общие критерии оценки качества условий осуществления образовательной деятельности организациями, осуществляющими образовательную деятельность по дополнительным профессиональным программам. Приказ Министерства науки и высшего образования РФ от 15 апреля 2019 г. N 31н.

Языковое содержание программы основано на лексическом и грамматическом материале English Profile <https://www.englishprofile.org/>

Актуальность программы определяется содержанием обучения, покрывающем широкий круг тем для повседневного общения во всех видах речевой деятельности, от беседы в повседневных ситуациях до переписки. При этом основной упор в обучении делается на практику устной речи через такой формат урока, как разговорный клуб. Учащиеся овладевают необходимым лексическим и грамматическим материалом в ходе онлайн-уроков с преподавателем и практикуют устное общение по тематике курса в формате разговорных клубов, основываясь на опорных вопросах и взаимодействуя с другими участниками общения и ведущим разговорного клуба. Содержание и форма подачи учебного материала соответствует интересам и жизненному опыту взрослых учащихся.

Новизна программы и ее отличительная особенность заключается в сочетании традиционного формата онлайн-уроков и разговорных клубов, а также в применении цифровых технологий и учете таких показателей, как время говорения обучающегося и преподавателя, правильность и время выполнения каждого задания, возможности для обучающегося оценивать учебные материалы. Перечисленные показатели используются для построения индивидуальной образовательной траектории обучающихся и более полном учете их индивидуальных потребностей, возможностей и интересов.

Особенности структуры курса: курс является модульным. Учащиеся начинают обучение с модуля, соответствующего текущему уровню их коммуникативной компетенции. Каждый модуль состоит из обязательных уроков, и основная часть модуля завершается итоговым экзаменом. Успешно прошедшим обучение в рамках модуля считается учащийся, прошедший все уроки и успешно сдавший экзамен по итогам модуля. Модуль также

включает разговорные клубы, которые являются дополнительными. Они направлены на дальнейшее совершенствование коммуникативной компетенции в рамках устной речи и могут использоваться как параллельно с уроками, так и после завершения основной части модуля, на усмотрения преподавателя. Таким образом, разговорные клубы являются инструментом построения индивидуальной образовательной траектории учащегося и более точного учета его интересов, способностей и уровня коммуникативной компетенции.

Курс построен на собственных разработках онлайн-школы Skyeng.

Педагогическая целесообразность программы обусловлена удовлетворением персональных образовательных потребностей обучающихся с учетом необходимых для работы умений.

Цель и задачи программы

Цель: развитие иноязычной коммуникативной компетенции обучающихся в совокупности ее составляющих: речевой, социокультурной, компенсаторной, учебно-познавательной и способствует решению следующих **задач**:

- речевая компетенция – развитие коммуникативных умений в четырех основных видах речевой деятельности (говорении, аудировании, чтении и письме);
- языковая компетенция – овладение новыми языковыми средствами (фонетическими, орфографическими, лексическими, грамматическими) в соответствии с темами и ситуациями общения; освоение знаний о языковых явлениях изучаемого языка, разных способах выражения мысли в родном и иностранном языках;
- социокультурная/межкультурная компетенция – приобщение к культуре, традициям, реалиям стран/страны изучаемого языка в рамках тем, сфер и ситуаций общения, отвечающих опыту, интересам, психологическим особенностям слушателей; формирование умения представлять свою страну, ее культуру в условиях межкультурного общения;
- компенсаторная компетенция – развитие умений выходить из положения в условиях дефицита языковых средств при получении и передаче информации;
- учебно-познавательная компетенция – дальнейшее развитие общих и специальных учебных умений, универсальных способов деятельности; ознакомление с доступными слушателям способами и приемами самостоятельного изучения языков и культур, в том числе с использованием информационных коммуникационных технологий;
- формирование у слушателей потребности изучения иностранных языков и овладения ими как средством общения, познания, самореализации и социальной адаптации в поликультурном полиэтническом мире в условиях глобализации на основе осознания важности изучения иностранного языка и родного языка как средства общения и познания в современном мире.

Форма обучения – заочная (дистанционная) на платформе «Образовательная платформа Скаенг Рус» (Edtech Platform Skyeng Rus).

Программа рассчитана на 1360 **академических часа** (час равен 50 минутам).

Характер занятий: все занятия носят практический характер.

Режим занятий формируется по индивидуальному плану обучающегося.

Планируемые результаты:

В результате освоения программы обучающиеся научатся *в пределах тематики программы*:

- воспринимать на слух монологическую и диалогическую речь носителей языка естественного темпа с общим пониманием, пониманием запрашиваемой информации;
- читать тексты различных жанров с общим пониманием, пониманием запрашиваемой информации;
- писать короткие функциональные тексты (записки, личные, деловые письма);
- в плане устной монологической и диалогической речи запрашивать и сообщать информацию, аргументированно высказывать точку зрения с учетом социокультурного контекста ситуации общения, делать публичные объявления, представлять себя и свою страну на изучаемом языке, выступать на производственных совещаниях, проводить переговоры;
- познакомятся с особенностями культуры стран изучаемого языка, необходимыми для успешной межкультурной коммуникации, в том числе с иностранными деловыми партнерами.

Контроль осуществляется в виде: текущего контроля (данные системы о результатах выполнения каждого упражнения урока), промежуточного контроля (контрольных уроков), разговорных клубов Topic Review (для разговорных клубов), итогового контроля в каждом модуле – итогового теста/экзамена, одновременно являющегося средством итоговой аттестации за модуль. Результат итогового теста представлен в баллах (100 максимально) или соответствующим буквенным значениям (A, B, C). Итоговая аттестация за весь курс проводится методом портфолио на по результатам выполнения итоговых контрольных заданий во всех пройденных модулях.

Материально-техническое обеспечение программы:

- 1) Персональный компьютер (стационарный компьютер/ноутбук).
- 2) Микрофон и наушник.
- 3) Установленная на персональный компьютер программа Skype.
- 4) Установленный на персональный компьютер браузер Google Chrome.

The next type is my favourite — a comedy. A cheerful story that centres on a confusing situation which causes conflict before a happy ending. The conflict involves a lot of funny misunderstandings, but finally, the confusion clears up and the main heroes celebrate the joy of life.

The fifth plot form is a tragedy. Despite the fact that the hero is initially a good person, they've made many mistakes in their life and therefore turn out to be frustrated with it. They can't resist temptation and end up undergoing a series of trials that lead to their downfall or even death.

The sixth plot type is opposite to the previous one: the rebirth of a villain. The protagonist is an unpleasant person who meets someone willing to help them redeem themselves. That person's job is to reveal the villain's hidden feelings and wishes and improve their world view.

These plot types are not the only ones you can follow. Feel free to combine them or think of something that falls outside all of these. Remember, these are a guide that is supposed to help you choose a plot to help get your message across.
